WHAT ARE THEY DOING?

Advent Health is an Adventist-Christian health organization. Advent Health is helping organization like Disney Springs Central FL and other businesses in Central FL open back up. They will be helping take temperatures. We asked, "How was Advent Health helping Disney specifically?" to Mrs. Stephanie Lind, Executive Director for Advent Health. She responds with, "Onsite clinics for the Disney cast, and a few Advent health professionals Onsite for Temperature checks for consumers."

WHAT PRECAUTIONS WILL YOU SEE?

Some things you can expect to see when going to either Disney or the Daytona Speedway are temperature checks. Advent Health employees will be stationed near entrances and exits of the park or event making sure everyone is healthy enough to enter. Another way that Advent Health is making sure the crowds are safe is through crowd control. At every temperature check-point and every store or kiosk there's an employee stationed to count the number of people inside. Advent Health has also provided signs and hand sanitizing stations to remind customers to social distance. There are already examples of these things happening at Disney Springs Orlando as of May 20, 2020.

Employees will be required to have a health screening and temperature check at home before coming to work. According to <http://www.disney Parks.disney.go.com/> "Disney Springs reopened May 20th and has a limited number of shops and restaurants opened but they are gradually going to open up but for now the rest of the resort is closed. They will continue to monitor conditions of health for their guests and staff. The cast members will get training to interact to the guests and promote social distancing. They will focus on hand washing.

AdventHealth is working to help reopen places like Disney Springs that they already had. You will see them taking temperatures, Limiting people in stores and restaurants, social distancing Signs, handwashing stations, and wearing masks. There are only limited stores and restaurants opened the rest of the resort is closed now but will gradually open up again. They will monitor health conditions here on out for the staff and customer's.
